This pamphlet gives you a list of transportation services available in the area. Ask your Case Manager or Job Coach to help you make the best transportation plan for you.

Here are some additional tips on getting to your job:

- ♥ Ask someone at work who lives close by or who passes near your house on their way to work if you can carpool with them. Offer to pay for gas, or buy them a coffee in the morning. You'll get there on time and make a new friend!
- ♥ Maybe you know someone who would be willing to drive you to the right bus stop, but not all the way to your job. Find out where bus stops near your house are, and see if someone can drive you to the stop.



UBER is a convenient, inexpensive and safe transport service that gets you a ride in minutes, day or night. There's no need to wait for a taxi or bus. Payment can be made by credit card, cash, Android Pay, or PayPal. You need to install the Uber app on your cell phone in order to use this system. Just go to the website and follow the directions on how to set up an account.
